WEEK ONE | born again, to new life.

You're called for more. More joy from the Holy Spirit. More grace from the love of Jesus. More life-giving community. More worship to our Creator. We pray that the Holy Spirit speaks through the pages of this devotional, and provides a new awakening and refreshment on what it means to be a daughter of the most High King. WEEK ONE | born again, to new life.

- Explore the conversation between Jesus and Nicodemus about being born again. Why does Jesus say you must be born again?

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- Read Genesis 3:15. Write down anything that stands out to you.

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What does Genesis 3:15 mean and how does this apply to John 1:1-21?

In the garden, Adam and Eve made a big mistake of listening to the serpent by eating the forbidden fruit instead of listening to God. However, that wasn't the end of their story. Naked and afraid both physically and mentally, they received God's grace. By being born again, we can receive His grace and experience freedom to live again.

WEEK ONE | born again, to new life.

- Look back on John 3:16. Write it down here. From reading this verse, why can we be born again?

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GENESIS 3:15 BREAKDOWN:

This verse was AFTER Adam and Eve listened to the serpent instead of God. Jesus was the heel that was bruised. God STILL kept His promise by giving Adam and Eve their offspring - children to build a nation. God gave Adam and Eve grace, **which follows all the way down to your generation.**

But, because of their choice to sin, He sent Jesus to bear our burdens on the cross so we could live as His people for eternity. Just like Adam and Eve, we have the choice to be born again under God's grace, receive and believe in what Jesus did. To live again, is to ask for help from God to obey his Word, and forgive us when we fall short so we can see His promises.

- If John 3:16 shares that God gave His only son to save you, then why is it a challenge to give yourself or other's grace?

WEEK ONE | born again, to new life.

- Now that you have the breakdown of Genesis 3:15 and read John 3:1-21, what does it mean to spiritually be reborn and start a new life in Jesus?

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- Looking back in John 3:1-21, how will the Holy Spirit help you live again?


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TAKE HEART

Yet Jesus, the Messiah, met her where she was and took the time to share about the living water. How can His love encourage you on days you feel dry, ashamed or empty?

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- How can you look back to this passage in a season of waiting and feeling hopeless? How did Jesus fulfill His promise and bring God glory?

WEEK THREE | the way, the truth and the life.

- What was the significance of Jesus as the resurrection and the life?

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TAKE HEART

Martha and Mary asked questions. So did the disciples. While their faith was lacking at times, their doubts didn't stop them from pursuing Jesus and it didn't stop Jesus from pursuing them. How can you reflect on this hope when challenging hardships come your way?

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- End this week by reminding yourself of the way, the truth and the life. Read John 14:1-14.
